


A simple-to-make paper finger puppet.

 Print out the template onto paper or thin card. Colour in a beak, eyes, feathers etc.






3. Fold the body lengthways; fold the wings first down along the central dotted fold line then upwards along the two outer dotted lines (creating the 'W' shape shown). 2. Cut out.





4. Glue the inside of the head and beak together - leaving the neck and body. Create a small paper loop for your finger and glue it on the underside of your seagull.

Flap, flap, flap!



Why not make a seagull mobile -

Simply make several puppets, omitting the finger loop and gluing the whole body together. Suspend from a coat hanger.

This pattern can also be used for sewn, felt puppets.
