Make an Underwater Mobile

A shimmering shoal of paper fish, or a host of simple felt underwater friends can make an effective mobile.

Use the templates below to make paper or card or lightly stuffed felt creatures.

Alternatively print the coloured templates twice and make them double sided by sticking them onto card.

Hang your fish from a coat hanger, or a cardboard ring or spiral. If you are lucky enough to live near a beach a cross or triangle made from small, tied together pieces of driftwood would look really effective.

I've used a cardboard ring cut from a box, wrapped with a strip of white tissue paper. I then cut paper fish shapes using the template below.

I used a needle and thick thread to hang them from the ring, and curling ribbon to hang the mobile.

Patterns for felt fish etc. can easily be found online; as can tutorials for beautiful origami fish which would also look beautiful!

Simple Underwater Scene Children's Craft

For an easy craft to make together print the coloured templates and stick onto a sheet of blue paper, using crayons or pens to draw seaweed and bubbles, and create a collage underwater scene.
